




# Hampshire Regional School District

# HRSD GOAL #1

Goal 1: Develop and implement district-wide (preK-12) curriculum (content, instruction and assessment) and a supportive organizational process to continually improve student performance

- Fully adopted a standards based report card aligned to school curriculum and State standards.
- Mapping school and district wide curriculum PK-12 for each content area
- Use MCAS student growth data to enhance student academic performance
- Use Math and ELA assessment data to help identify strengths and weaknesses in instructional programs
- Provide focused academic support for students-at-risk
- Data Warehouse (move from TestWiz to DESE data management)
- Professional Growth, Supervision, and Evaluation

# HRSD GOAL #2

Goal 2: Promote professional development as a means of improving instruction and student achievement including content, instruction, assessment, mentoring and coaching

- In the second year of a district-wide literacy initiative, we are identifying and implementing specific professional development opportunities that enhance literacy outcomes for all students. (Development of Literacy Action Plan)
- District collaboration on planning professional development to align our ELA curriculum PK -8 that incorporates curriculum, instruction, and assessment, remediation and targeted support
- Collaborations with Westfield State University, Collaborative for Educational Service, and District Support and Accountability Center (DSAC)
- Mentors are provided to all new professional staff
- Communities of Practice (COP) to support adult learning

# HRSD GOAL #3

Goal 3: Support the use of technology, differentiated instruction, diversity and community service as instructional strategies to reach all learners

- Academic Support Services (MCAS after school and course offering support)
- Lego Robotics Grant
- Interactive Boards
- Response to Intervention Strategies
- Community service including a graduation requirement which brings HRHS student volunteers to our community elementary schools
- Disability Awareness training at the classroom and school community levels
- Technology Integration and Math Instruction (Collaboration with Easthampton)
- United Streaming, A+ Advantage, Study Island
- Teacher Trainers and presentors in statewide technology initiatives

# HRSD GOAL #4

Goal #4: Facilitate ongoing and open communication with parents and communities

- Updated School Web Sites
- Electronic communications (increasing outreach using electronic communication)
- Newsletters – School, PTO, Classroom etc..
- Connect-Ed – Our automated telephone calling system
- Community outreach such as grandparents day, monthly community celebrations, Veteran’s Day celebrations, PTO Family Workshops Series and Guiding Good Choices program.
- New efforts to promote HRSD Schools

Goal #5: Provide for the daily safety and welfare of all students

- Lockdowns: Collaboration with Local and State Police involvement
- Upgrades in security procedures such as one monitored point of entry
- Bullying prevention policy and procedures supported by staff and parent workshops and educational programming for students.

- Life Threatening Food Allergy Policy and Management


